Kiss the Blarney Stone

Climb the winding staircase of one of Ireland's most famous castles and lean back to kiss the legendary Stone of Eloquence. Whether you believe in the gift of gab or not, the views from the battlements are worth every step. Wander the lush gardens and ancient yew trees that surround this 600-year-old fortress.



Stand Atop the Cliffs of Moher

Nothing quite prepares you for the moment these towering sandstone cliffs come into view — 700 feet of sheer rock face plunging straight into the churning Atlantic below. Walk the clifftop path, feel the ocean wind, and take in panoramic views that stretch to the Aran Islands on a clear day. It's Ireland at its most dramatic.



Drive the Ring of Kerry

Ireland's most famous scenic route winds 100 miles along the wild Kerry coastline — past rocky shores, emerald fields dotted with sheep, mountain passes, and tiny colorful villages. 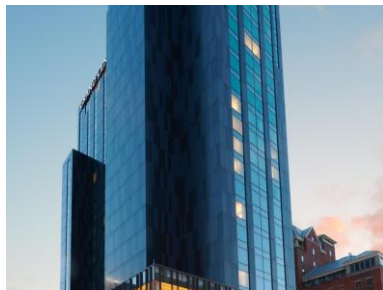

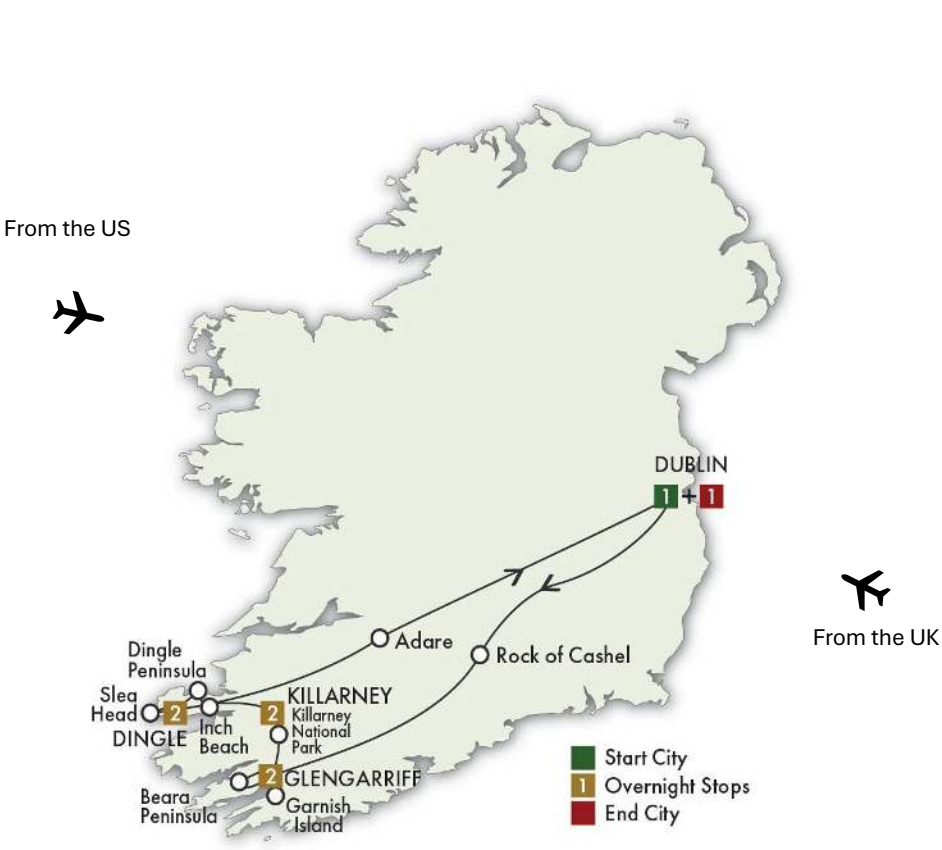

This guided walking tour winds through Ireland's stunning southwestern corner — from the medieval Rock of Cashel to the wild Beara Peninsula, through Killarney National Park, and along the dramatic Dingle Peninsula. Each day blends active hiking with meaningful cultural encounters and warm Irish hospitality.

Ideal for active travelers who love to explore on foot. Expect scenic walks of 2–6 miles daily on mostly gentle paths and hill trails, with occasional muddy or rough sections and climbs up to 1,500 feet.

Day 1 **Dublin**

Arrive in Dublin and join a guided walking tour of the city at 2:30 PM. Explore historic streets, impressive Georgian architecture, famous landmarks, and hidden gems as your guide shares insights into Dublin's unique character. Welcome drink and group dinner at a popular Dublin restaurant. **D**

Day 2 **Rock of Cashel & West Cork**

Journey south toward West Cork with a stop at the Rock of Cashel, a medieval monastic site perched atop a limestone hill. Walk among Celtic crosses, ancient church ruins, and a round tower as you learn about Ireland's rich past. Then hop on a short boat ride to Garnish Island, a subtropical garden paradise with rare plants, Italianate sculptures, and peaceful ponds tucked into tranquil pathways. Free evening back in Glengarriff. (2 hr 30min 5 mile) **B+L**

Day 4 **Farm visit & Beara Hike**

Get your hands dirty at Molly Gallivan's Cottage and Traditional Farm – try cutting turf from the bog the old-fashioned way, then knead a loaf of soda bread and watch it bake over an open hearth. After, embark on a hike through the Beara Peninsula, taking in heather-covered hills, dramatic sea cliffs, and serene lakes. Packed lunch along the way. Continue to Killarney for dinner at your hotel. (3 hr 30 min 4 ½ mile) **B+L+D**

Day 5 **Killarney National Park & Muckross House**

Cross Lough Leane by boat, then hike along well-defined paths through ancient oak woodlands – one of the last remnants of Ireland's native forest. Packed lunch near the thundering Torc Waterfall. Tour the lavishly furnished rooms of Muckross House, a grand Victorian mansion, and stroll through its manicured gardens and lakeside paths. Evening free to explore the lively streets of Killarney town. (3 hr 6 milr) **B+L**

Day 6 **Inch Strand & Dingle**

Walk the wide, golden sweep of Inch Strand – a stunning sandy beach stretching between the Dingle Peninsula and the Ring of Kerry. Watch for seabirds wheeling overhead and dolphins playing offshore. Continue into colorful Dingle town for lunch in a local pub. The rest of the day is yours – browse craft shops, wander the harbor, or pull up a stool for a traditional Irish music session. (1 hr 3 mile) **B+L**

Day 7 **Slea Head & Blasket Centre**

Today's hike is the showstopper. Follow the Slea Head trail along the western tip of the Dingle Peninsula – past ancient beehive huts, stone-walled fields, clifftop farmhouses, and jaw-dropping Atlantic views with the Blasket Islands shimmering on the horizon. Packed lunch on the trail. Afterwards, visit the Blasket Centre, a museum dedicated to the extraordinary literary heritage of the island community. Group dinner in Dingle. (4hr 6 mile) **B+L+D**

Day 8 **Adare & Dublin**

Head back toward Dublin with a stop in Adare, one of Ireland's prettiest villages – famous for its thatched-roof cottages, medieval ruins, and charming craft boutiques. Stroll the picturesque streets and browse the shops. Lunch with your group along the way. Arrive in Dublin, bid farewell to your guide, and enjoy a free evening to dine and explore as you wish. **B+L**

Day 9 **Tour ends in Dublin**

Your tour ends after breakfast. Depart Dublin at your leisure, or extend your stay to explore the city on your own. **B**

Hike the Wild Beara Peninsula

Lace up your boots and head into one of Ireland's most untouched landscapes. Walk Among History at the Rock of Cashel

Rising from the green Tipperary plains like something out of a legend, the Rock of Cashel has watched over Ireland for more than a thousand years. Walk among medieval church ruins, Celtic high crosses, and a 12th-century round tower — all perched on a dramatic limestone outcrop with sweeping views in every direction.



Coastal Hike Along Slea Head

The western edge of the Dingle Peninsula is where Ireland meets the open Atlantic — and the views are staggering. Hike the Slea Head trail past ancient stone walls, clifftop farmhouses, and beehive huts older than memory, with the ghostly silhouette of the Blasket Islands floating on the horizon. Afterwards, visit the Blasket Centre to discover the remarkable literary legacy of the islanders who once called them home.



Hands-On Traditions at Molly Gallivan's Farm

Step into rural Ireland as it was lived for centuries. At this restored 19th-century farmstead, you'll try your hand at cutting turf from the bog, knead a loaf of traditional soda bread, and watch it bake over an open-hearth fire. It's the kind of authentic, sleeves-rolled-up experience that turns a good trip into an unforgettable one.

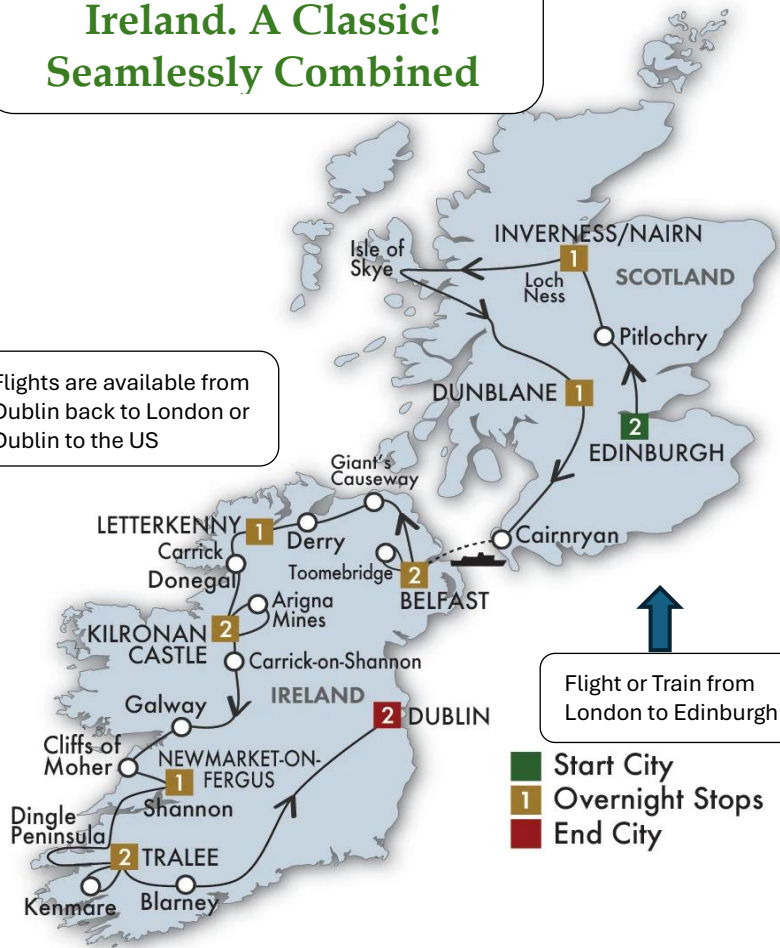
