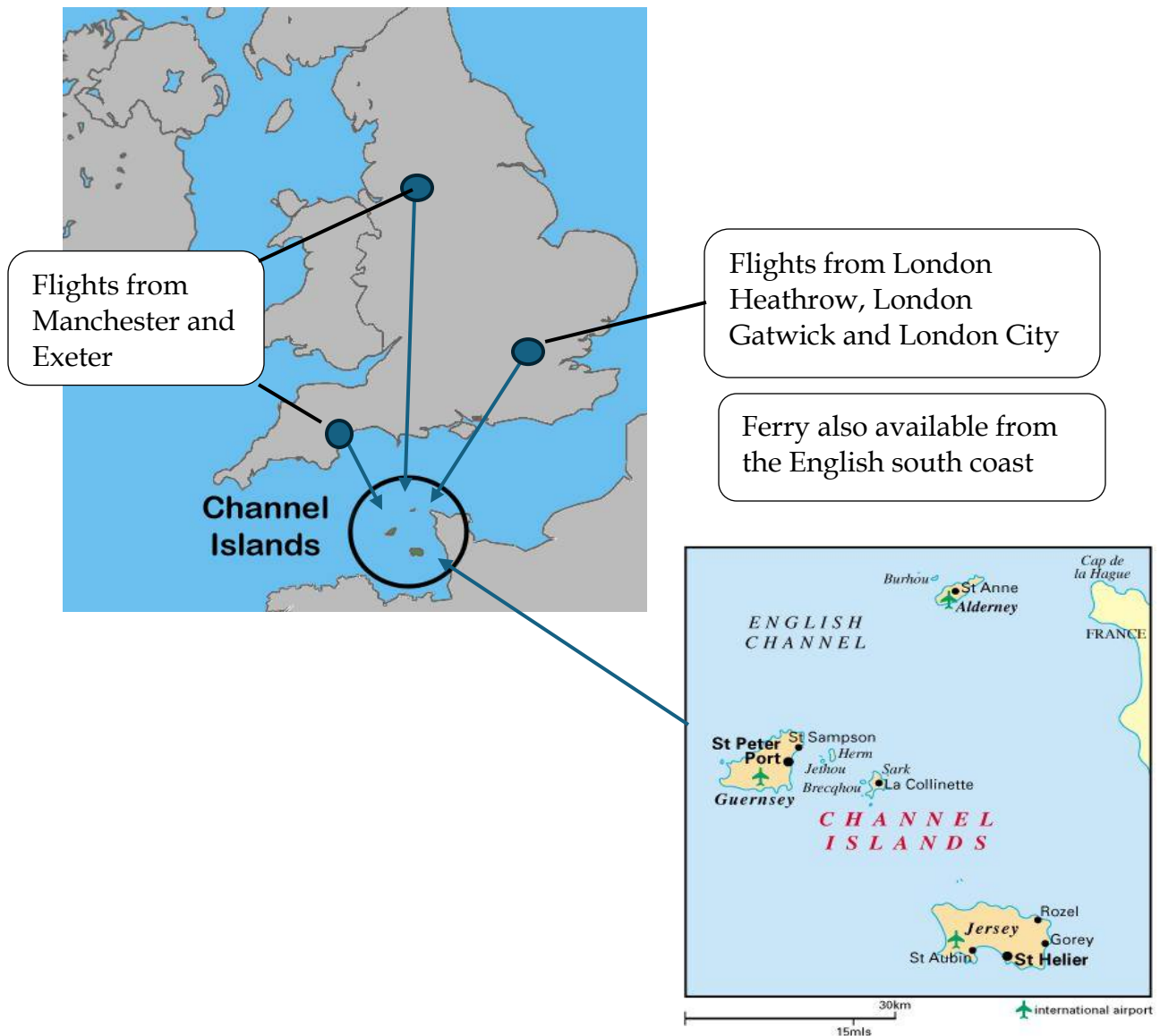

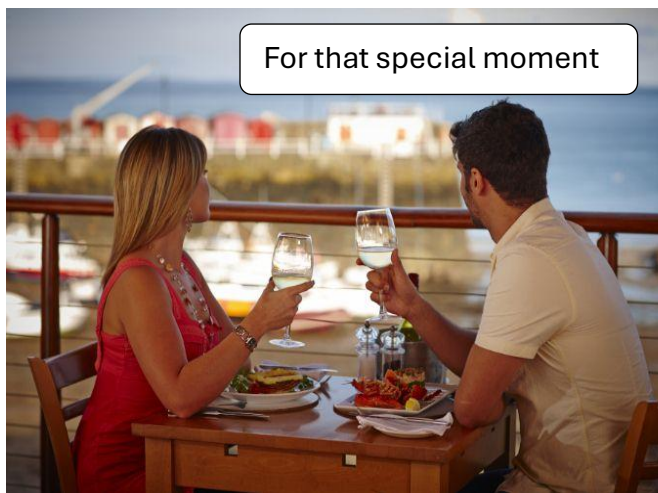

The Island of Guernsey

Accessible by a 20-minute boat crossing from Guernsey

Herm is an idyllic retreat from everyday life. Just a mile and a half long and half mile wide, with no cars, the island is like nowhere else. Breathtaking stretches of white sandy beaches, award winning gardens, and a beautiful coastline, make it impossible not to fall in love with this tranquil little island. Take lunch at one of the islands three restaurants before leaving this wonderful island.

The Island of Sark and Little Sark

Accessible by Boat from Guernsey

Take a step back in time to the perfect little world of Sark. Like Herm, **Sark is car-free**, so on arrival in the harbour hop on the legendary 'toast rack' (a makeshift tractor-pulled minibus) to come up harbour hill and then navigate the island either on foot, by bicycle or horse-drawn carriage. The main island is just over two square miles, and must-sees are La Seigneurie Gardens, the Venus and Adonis Pools.

The Island Alderney

Accessible by Ferry or Flight from Jersey

Alderney is the most northerly of the islands and just 8 miles from the coast of Normandy, France. The town of St. Annes is just a short walk from the Harbor. With its narrow cobbled streets, the town is quaint, friendly and with little cafes and shops., The island is abundant with wildlife and is a paradise for nature lovers. The island has an ancient and varied history and has its own steam train.

Lihou is part of Guernsey's Ramsar site which also encompasses wetland reserves. Home to variety of wildlife including 150 species of bird. Perfect for a day trip. This tiny island is a great place for exploration! Visit the ruined priory, trace the coastline in search of wildlife and
